



COVID POLICY

The ATA e-Business Program takes the safety and wellbeing of its attendees very seriously. As the situation with COVID-19 is changing daily, we are closely monitoring the response by healthcare and government officials so we can help ensure the protection of all attendees. To help ensure the safety of all attendees, ATA and The Hyatt Regency Lake Washington will be requiring all attendees to adhere to updated recommendations and mandates set by the CDC, the federal government, and state/local government for large gatherings. Requirements for attending the event may include but are not limited to wearing a mask, providing proof of vaccination, or providing proof of a negative COVID-19 test.

Due to the unprecedented and evolving COVID-19 pandemic we recognize the need for flexibility in making changes to your attendance. If the e-Business Forum is cancelled due to national, state, or local COVID-19 restrictions or an attendee is unable to travel to the event based on their local/international travel restrictions, the attendee will receive a full refund of their registration. Note that for travel restrictions, the travel must be directly affected during the week of June 20, 2022, to qualify for the refund.
