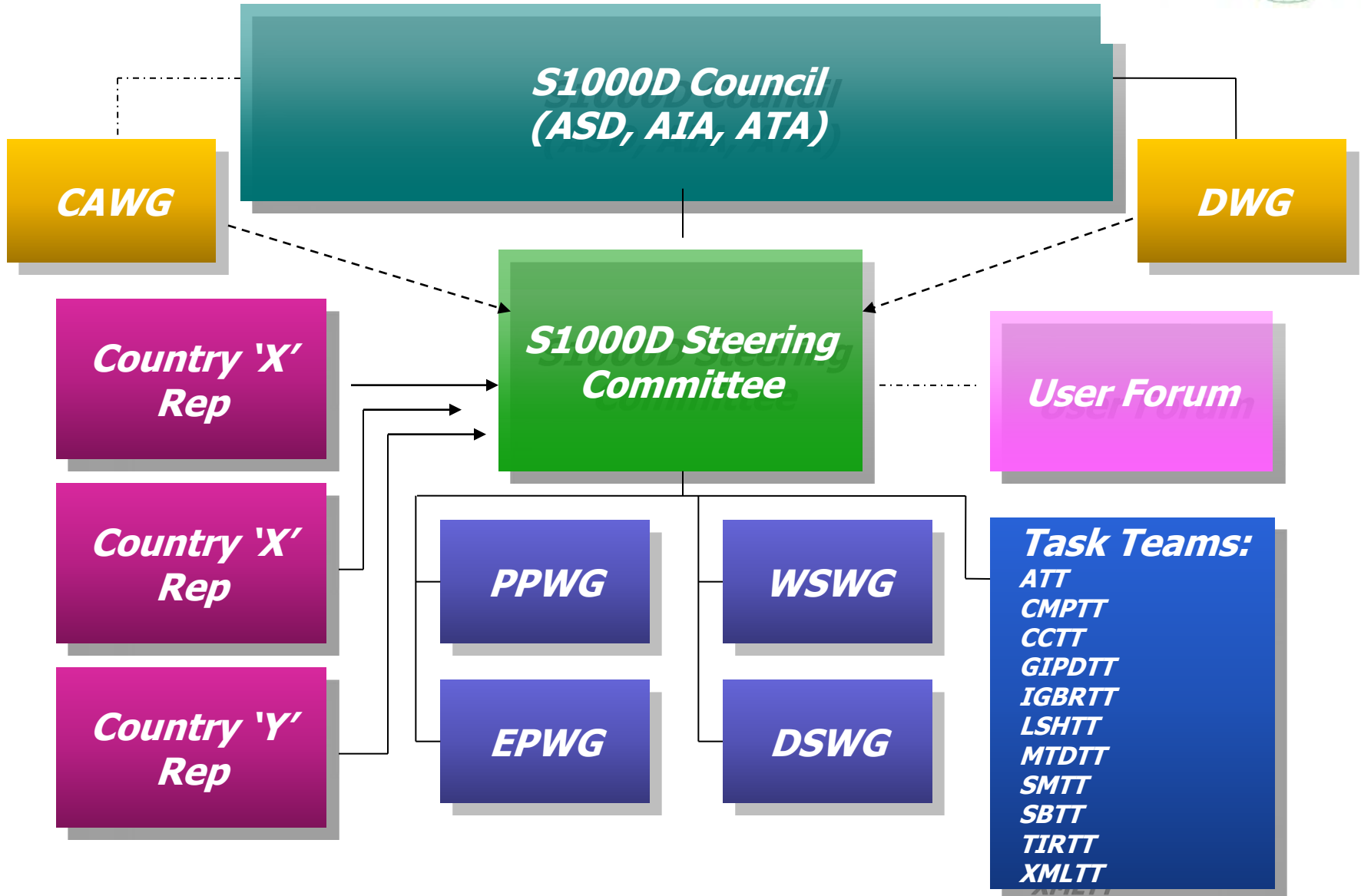

# MOU between ADL and S1000D Council



Memorandum of Understanding  
Between  
The United States Department of Defense  
Advanced Distributed Learning (ADL) Initiative  
and  
The S1000D Council



The Parties will continue to further the above and co-ordinate their activities through the newly formed S1000D Steering Committee Learning Standards Harmonization Task Team and in association with the ADL Initiative.

The S1000D Council and Steering Committee will ensure the engagement of technical information specialists, whilst the ADL Co-Labs and ADL Partnership Lab network will be a research avenue for leveraging new concepts and emerging technologies that advance learning adaptability and data readiness.

Cooperation will be achieved by an ongoing program of work agreed between the parties. This program of work will include:

- Continued refinement and advancement of technical training support in S1000D
- Continued harmonization of S1000D and SCORM that leads to data readiness and learning content management cost savings.

The Parties agree to continue sharing access to technical data and material, as required, to achieve the ongoing work program. Information so provided shall be used for the sole purposes of standards and enterprise application development undertaken pursuant to this MoU. Each Party agrees not to release information obtained from the other beyond its own membership, unless the other parties provide permission.

#### **COPYRIGHT/INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS**

ASD and the MOD's of the countries of the ASD members will remain the holders of the copyright on the past and current and future issues of S1000D. ADL's use of such copyrighted materials shall be governed by a separate license agreement between it and those entities.

#### **REPRESENTATION AT S1000D STEERING COMMITTEE**

ADL will be represented by an observer at the S1000D Steering Committee.

#### **VALIDITY AND TERMINATION**

This MoU may be reviewed at any time at the request of any party. Any amendment to the MoU must be reviewed and unanimously approved by the parties. Any party may terminate this MoU with three months written notice to the other parties. In the event that this MoU is terminated, each party retains its rights as defined above.

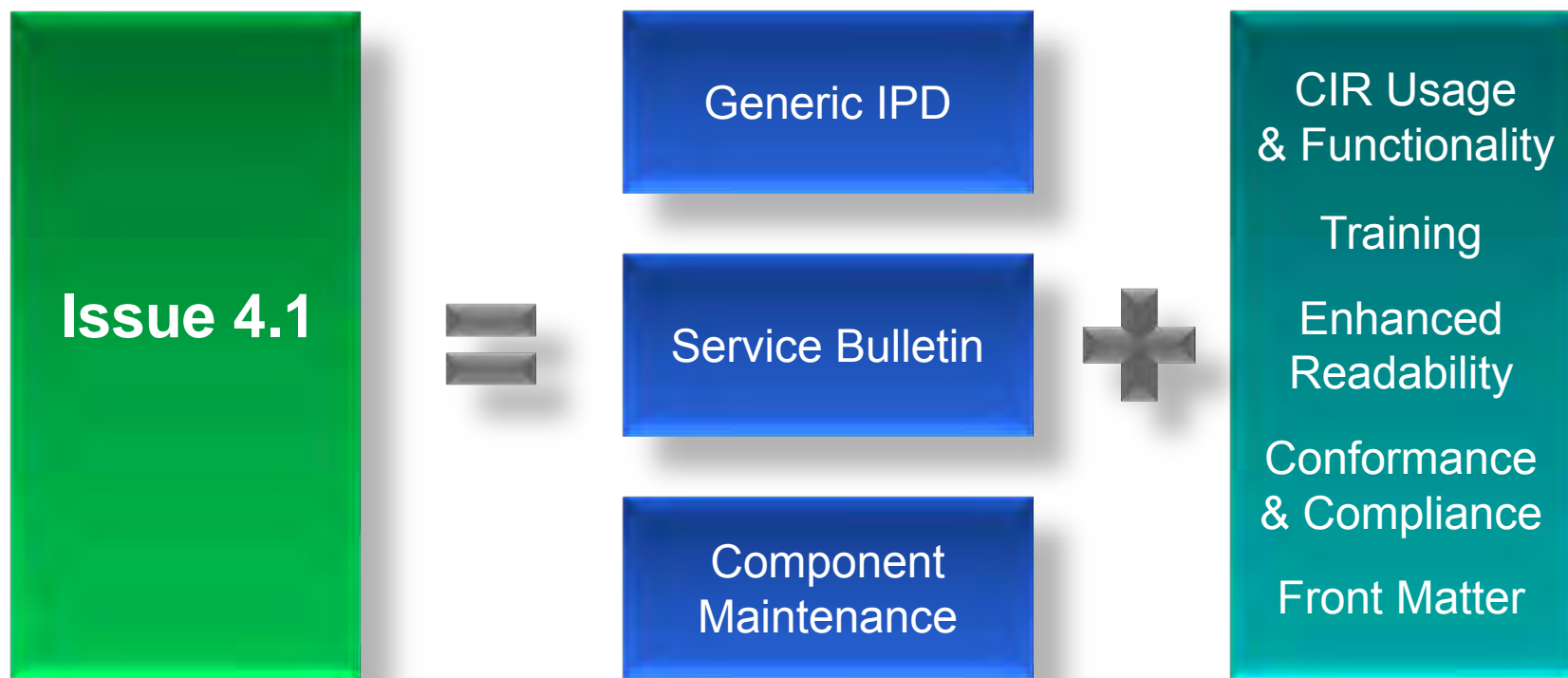

- S1000D future planning (roadmap after 4.1) based on nations and organization priorities is under development
- Top priority will be S1000D modularization
- Modularization = restructuring and stabilization of S1000D to:
  - Ease acquisition and avoid contracting issues
  - Clarify core and optional constructs
  - Better support software development
